

Breward describes its adoption by women and its usefulness as an index of character in painting, photography and film. And finally, at a moment when suit-wearing appears to be on the decline, will it survive in the twentyfirst century and in the human imagination? Beautifully illustrated and written with authority, Suit offers new perspectives on this most mundane, and yet poetic, product of modern culture.
